1. About the Club

Siena Netball Club was established in 2012 by Kaylene Buckley to give girls and boys opportunities to grow their netball skills and enjoy competitive play beyond the school setting. Our club is fully volunteer-run and welcomes students from across the Sunshine Coast, with our base located at Siena Catholic Primary School and Siena Catholic College.

We currently support over 190 players across 22 teams, ranging from ages 7 to 18. Our weekly coaching sessions include skills, drills, and match play in a friendly and safe environment. We strive to reflect the values of both Siena Primary and Secondary, with a strong focus on improvement, sportsmanship, and community support.

Training is held at Siena Primary School and College on Tuesday afternoons between 3:15pm and 5:30pm. Fixtures are played at Sunshine Coast Netball Association, Fishermans Road, on Saturdays.

Net Set Go White (Ages 9–10)

- Non-competitive; full netball rules.
- Qualified umpires used.

- **Fee: \$414**

Net Set Go Green & Gold (Ages 7–9)

- Non-competitive; modified rules.
- Beginner umpires provided.
- Training: Tuesdays 3:15–4:15pm.
- Fixtures: Saturdays at SCNA.
- **Fee: \$378**

Net Set Go Blue (Ages 5–7)

- Skills-based, non-team program.
- Run by SCNA staff.
- Saturdays (shorter season starting mid-May).

- Skill level and versatility
- Prior team experience
- Competitive readiness

8. Use of Club Fees

The Siena Netball Club fee (\$85 per player) supports:

9. Financial Hardship Policy

Siena Netball Club is committed to ensuring that every player has the opportunity to take the court, regardless of their financial situation. We recognize that families may occasionally face exceptional and unforeseen circumstances that make meeting registration costs difficult

The Financial Hardship Policy is designed to provide temporary relief for families and it is important

to note:

Purpose: This policy is reserved for genuine hardship and is not an alternative payment plan or a standard instalment option.

Discretion: All applications are reviewed and executed solely by the Executive Committee.

Privacy: We hold the privacy of our families in the highest regard. Your circumstances will be handled with the utmost sensitivity and will not be discussed with the wider Siena community, including coaches, managers, or other club members.

How to apply

1. Formal Request: Contact the Siena Netball Club Executive Committee in writing via general@sienanetballclub.com.

2. Approval & Invoicing: Once your application is reviewed and approved, a specific hardship invoice will be issued within 7 days of the close of registration.

3. Fortnightly Payment Commitment: Payments are to be made on a fortnightly basis via direct deposit into the Siena Netball Club bank account. A minimum payment of 10% per registration is required each fortnight to maintain active status.

4. Final Balance Deadline: To ensure players remain eligible for the second half of the season, the total balance of fees must be paid in full prior to the return of rounds following the June/July holiday Break.

10. Play On Vouchers

We are a registered Play On Activity Provider. Eligible families can apply for a \$200 voucher to use toward fees. Limit: one per child per year.

11. Uniform Policy

Required Uniform:

- Siena Netball Dress: \$75
- Club Bike Pants: \$35 (*plain black bike pants are also acceptable*)

Optional Merchandise:

- Soft Peak Netball Visor: \$16
- Netball Visor (Option 2): \$11
- Hoodie: \$55
- Training Shirt: Issued to all players in 2026
- Siena Netball Ribbon: \$15.00

- Supporter Earrings: \$10.00
- Umbrella: \$25
